Conditions of Entry

- Entrants must be enrolled within a Primary or Secondary school within the Woollahra Council Local Government Area.
- Each entry must be an original work and only one entry per student is to be submitted.
- Entrants should include a short (50-100 words) explanation of how their sculpture relates to the theme 'Keep the sea plastic-free'.
- Sculptures must be three dimensional (3D), no larger than 80cm in size in any dimension, and no heavier than 3kg.
- Each sculpture must be stable and able to stand up on its own without support.
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- A list of all participating students must be included with this entry form, and each entry must have identifying details attached (student's name, class and school).
- Entry forms, accompanying lists and sculptures must be received by Council no later than **Friday 17 October 2008**. Forms and lists may be emailed, faxed or posted. Sculptures must be hand delivered to Council Chambers.

Further information

- Finalists will be chosen by Council environmental staff on the basis of originality, creativity and adherence to the theme of the competition.
- The winner of the *2008 Woollahra Environmental Sculpture Schools Award* will be chosen from finalists' entries by an independent judge.
- Finalists' work will be displayed at Council Chambers during the Woollahra Small Sculpture Prize exhibition from 25 October – 2 November 2008.
- During exhibition week, all visitors will have the opportunity to vote for the finalist's sculpture they judge to be the best. The sculpture with the most votes will receive the *People's Choice Award*.
- While all care will be taken with sculptures, Council cannot be held responsible for any theft or damage.
